- 1. Approval of minutes from October 17th, 2022 meeting
 - a. T. Howes motioned, T. Danehy seconded, and the minutes were approved unanimously. B. Greenleaf asbstained.
- 2. Welcome/Introductions with D. Neel, COO of Branford Public Schools
 - a. D. Neel was not present. S. Kaminsky stated that she is meeting with him this afternoon to explain more about the collaborative and discuss whether joining is a viable option.
 Branford has about 450 lives but we do not know about their claim history.
- 3. Bid Process Timeline
 - a. C. Petruccione shared a document that outlined the bid process from 11/21/22 3/20/23, from projections to the final meeting and selection.
- 4. Q&A Monthly Reports:
 - a. C. Petruccione reviewed the reports for each entity through October. All entities are running just below budget, as expected for this time of year.
- 5. ACES EAP Utilization
 - a. D. Carson shared the most recent Curalinc EAP Utilization report. The program includes 6 sessions of counseling and work-life benefits. Annualized utilization is 4.36%, 20 cases have been opened and 100% resolved within the EAP. Most common issue is personal stress. There have been 425 visits to the website and 126 app downloads. Given that the program began on 5/1/22 and the summer months are slow, the data is promising. Carson shared promotional flyers and stated that Curalinc will come for an in-person mindfulness presentation at one of the schools on 1/17/23 for PD day. Four worksite hours per year are included.
