How to Apply

To be considered for admission, you must:


- 1. Register for the informational session provided to interested international families sponsored by ACES ECA. Special consideration can be requested if an interested family has missed the deadline for registration. Contact <u>ecainfo@aces.org</u>
- 2. Submit a completed application packet by November 10 of each year to ACES ECA. This must include:
 - a) Application
 - b) Recommendations
 - c) Transcript of past two years for formal education records
- 3. Designate ACES Educational Center for the Arts as a recipient of your grades for review. Transcripts and official records must be sent to the attention of the Director's International Office.
