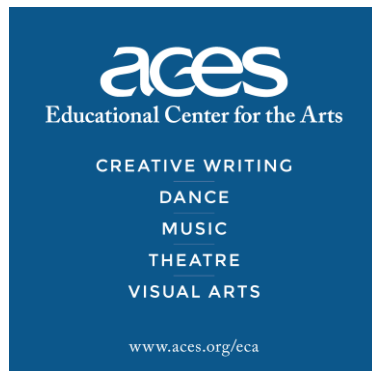

How to Apply

2. Submit a completed application packet by November 10 of each year to ACES ECA.
This must include:
 - a) Application
 - b) Recommendations
 - c) Transcript of past two years for formal education records
3. Designate *ACES Educational Center for the Arts* as a recipient of your grades for review.
Transcripts and official records must be sent to the attention of the Director's International Office.
